



It is with great excitement that we report the highlights of the ministry of the Central Baptist Seminary for the 2022-2023 school year. We have seen only increases in the number of students enrolled for classes in the last three years. This year, we have started with 48 students taking various courses. This increase in our enrollment has given rise to a need to travel more often to visit churches, youth meetings, individual pastors, and associational meetings in Mexico in order to promote the seminary. Our trips have given us an opportunity to communicate with our brethren and showcase our classes and future plans for the institution. It has also given us the chance to speak with young men and pastors to invite them to enroll.

Last year, we began the construction of our new Seminary building. As you may remember, we were able to purchase the lot next door to our current facility, and we began the work. We hope that construction will continue through the first part of next year. We are building only as funds become available, which means that our Seminary has no debt.

This school year will be the first that our Presidential Lectures will be held in the month of April rather than in March, as it has been since our inception. We are hoping to invite one of the professors from Texas Baptist Institute to be our guest speaker this year. We will keep you informed and report the outcome.

For 38 years, we have ministered by preparing men and women to better serve God. Throughout this time, many of you have partnered with us by praying, visiting, sharing in the physical labor, and sending offerings. We thank you from the bottom of our hearts and ask you to take the time to make a trip to visit and encourage us and see for yourself what God is doing in Cd. Acuña. We also ask that you continue to pray for us as we continue to minister for the Lord. May God continue to richly bless you.
