

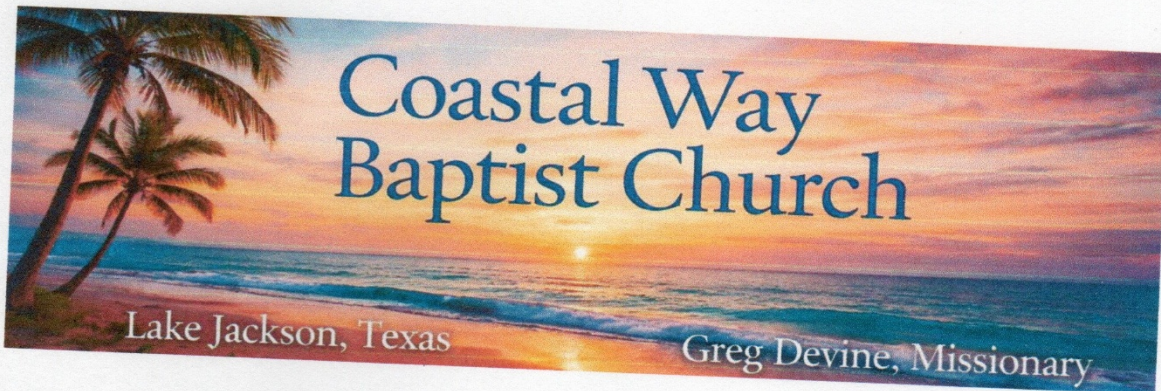

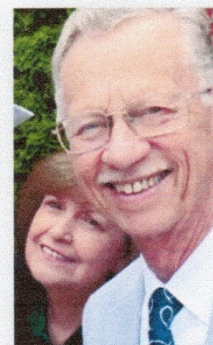
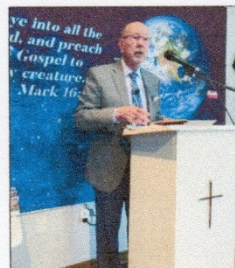
Bro Josh Doremus: Josh is with Macedonian and does

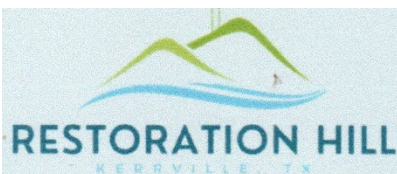
