

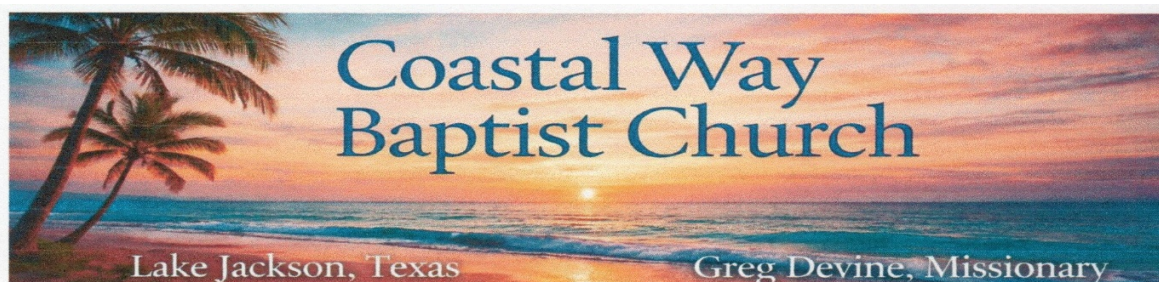

Missions Report 8/31/26

With July being as busy it was, August provided us an opportunity to catch our breath and review the first half of the year. We wanted to share some of that with you this month.

The church has been doing well, and we have been watching God move in our regular attendees as well as gaining some newcomers. We are still averaging around 20 to 30 in attendance. With some dropping out while others are stepping in, the number hasn't moved much in a year. Our monthly outreaches are being well received within the community, and our people are beginning to see the benefit to themselves and God's Kingdom. The congregation has been growing in their faith concerning giving and they have also been supporting Project 247 in Indonesia. Watching their excitement of how they are able to be a part of bringing the Gospel to those on the other side of the world is very encouraging.

Another encouraging sign is how our social media presence has increased. We have been making a push all year to reach more people with the Gospel through the gift of social media. God has blessed in this effort. With the help of Chad Helton with Crazy Faith Designs, we have seen our social media efforts make an impact. You can now find our influence on Facebook, Instagram, Youtube, Spotify, and TikTok. I have included some of the numbers below.



Facebook is one of the primary sources that we use. We now have over 300 followers and over 4500 views of our reels. We have gotten over 100 reactions to our reels and we have seen the traffic on the church FB page increase. 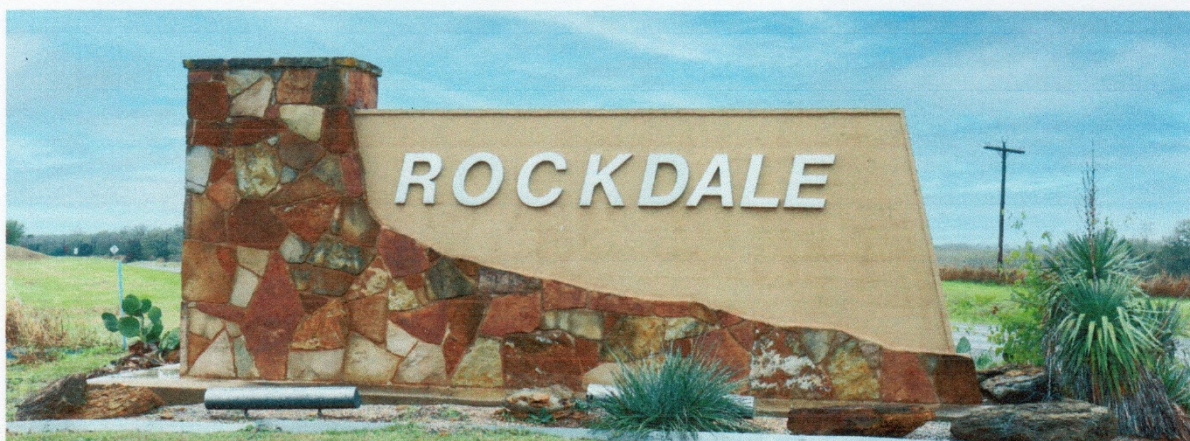
