
Missions Report 1/31/26





WELCOME BACK!!!

We were finally able to welcome students back for the Spring semester as we held our first meeting of the semester on January 19th. We picked back up in our series on Proverbs and I had discussion questions that each of the kids seemed to like. We discussed a service project for the upcoming semester and some ideas for more campus outreach.

We were able to have a display set up for the Welcome Back Fair on January 15th, and we were able to make a few contacts from that. The biggest thing has been getting to be as active as we possibly can on the campus. On January 29th, we had our first worship night of the semester and we had two new students. They had found us in part of our Student Organization page on the Texas Tech website, but also through our campus outreach. We pray for more opportunities to reach out even more!


