We were also blessed to have Bro. John McElroy with the B.E.A.M.S. Ministry, reminding us of the importance of getting God's Word into the hands of people around the world.

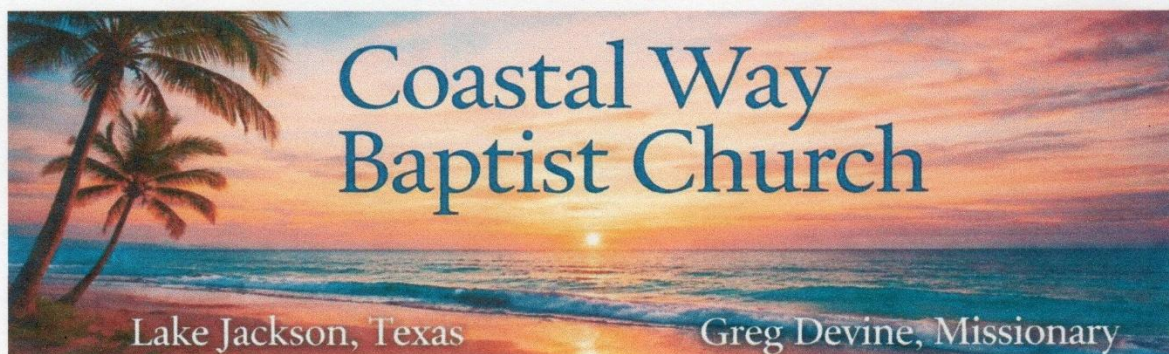
Another blessing this month was welcoming Pastor Larry's parents back to Rockdale. We are thankful they are able to worship with us regularly as part of our church family.

Lifeline Ladies Fellowship:

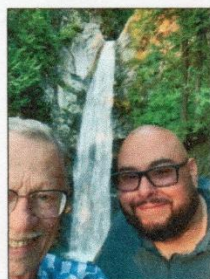


Our ladies love their fellowships. They have great times together with a great teacher-Susanne Moore.

Missions Report 7/31/26

July was a crazy month for RHC. This was our second year to promote and carry out a major outreach effort in the Kerrville/Ingram area. It was also the second year that a major rain event flooded the area just before our outreach. It's not how we wanted it, but God once again prepared the hearts of the community for the 70 people who came out to assist us in reaching the community for Christ.



We started our first day with preparation by having Hugh Roth with OBP teach everyone how to effectively share the Gospel. Then our teams ate lunch and got all of their gear together to be ready for our 2 days of community outreach. We had teams of people out doing Totally Free car wash, Grace Grill, Store to Store, and Random Acts of Kindness.

Jason Enochs with RFG was able to attend a local skate park competition and give away RFG gear to some of the participants.



Overall, the event was a huge success. We served over 200 free hot dogs, gave out over 400 bottles of water, washed almost 100 cars,

and made contact with countless people. The most exciting part of it all was that 4 people made professions of faith through our evangelistic efforts. Praise God! We are grateful to all that came and supported the work here in the Hill Country. I pray that you all were blessed as much as you blessed this community.
