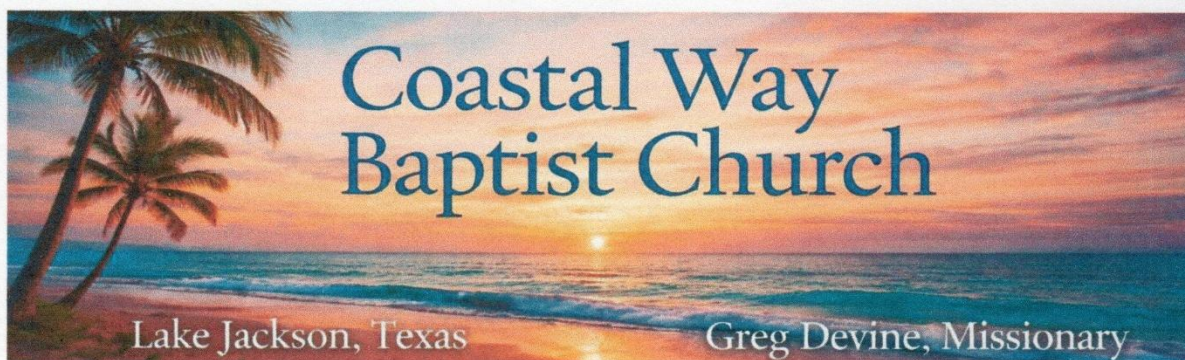

This report is not about the work we did this month, but rather about the work of our 190 guests who came for the 2026 Impact outreach. Youth and their adult sponsors traveled to Lake Jackson from sister churches in Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, Missouri, Kansas, Mississippi, and Texas. For 12 years, Impact (I Must Personally Advance Christ Today) has been blessing host churches and visiting workers with the opportunity to share God's love in a big way in different cities. During the week of June 15, outreach teams were scattered throughout Lake Jackson and Clute for car washes, prayer tents, neighborhood outreach, and many different service projects. Impact outreaches have been a beacon of God's love and the Gospel for the past 12 years, and this year the workers showed their dedication and resilience in a whole new way. The work didn't stop for a rainy Tuesday, or for an even rainier Wednesday morning as Tropical Storm Arthur made its way up the gulf coast. Some planned outreach locations were flooded, but the teams found other places to be, and other ways to be a blessing to Lake Jackson. Nobody quit, and nobody gave up. Wednesday afternoon and all day Thursday had clear skies and sunshine, and the outreach continued in earnest. People from all over Lake Jackson shared personally, and even on Facebook how they had been blessed by the prayers, water bottles, conversations, and other ways that they had been impacted. Thank you Lord, and thank you to all the workers who made this week very special, and made a great name for Coastal Way Baptist Church in our community.

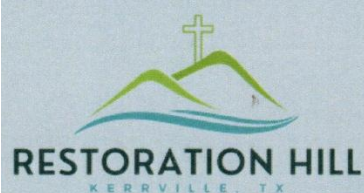

Missions Report 6/30/26

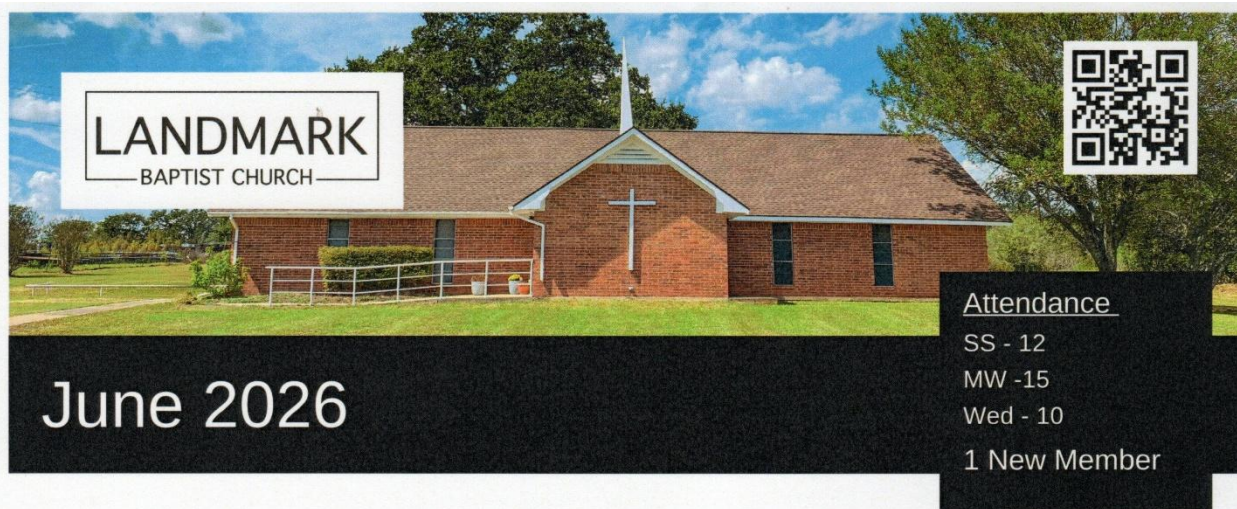

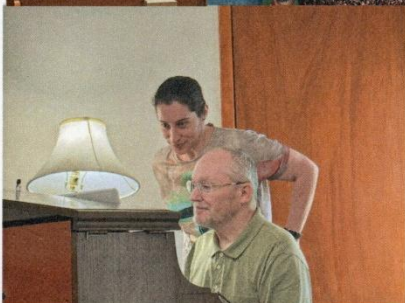
June's attendance was down just a little as families traveled during the summer, but we are thankful the Lord continues to bless and sustain our church.
