

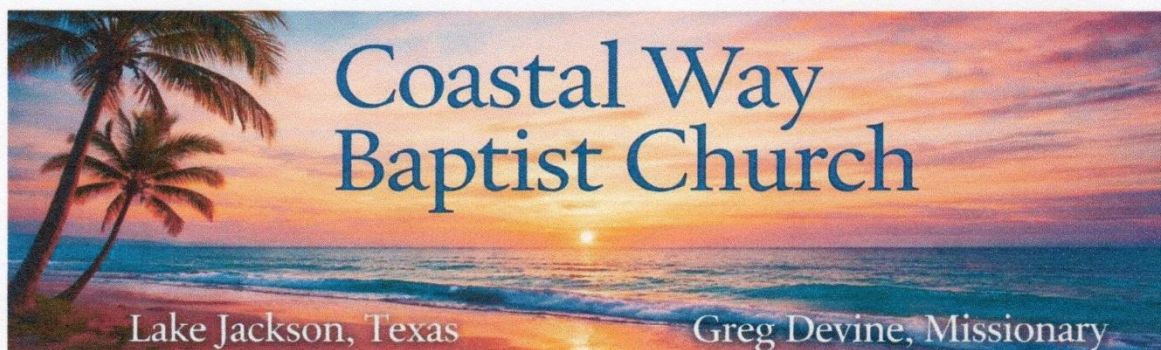

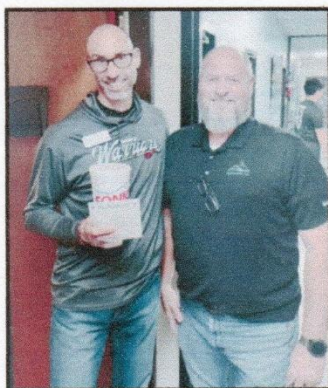

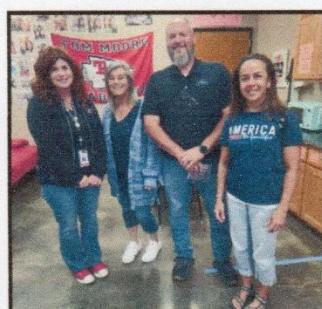


## Missions Report 3/31/26

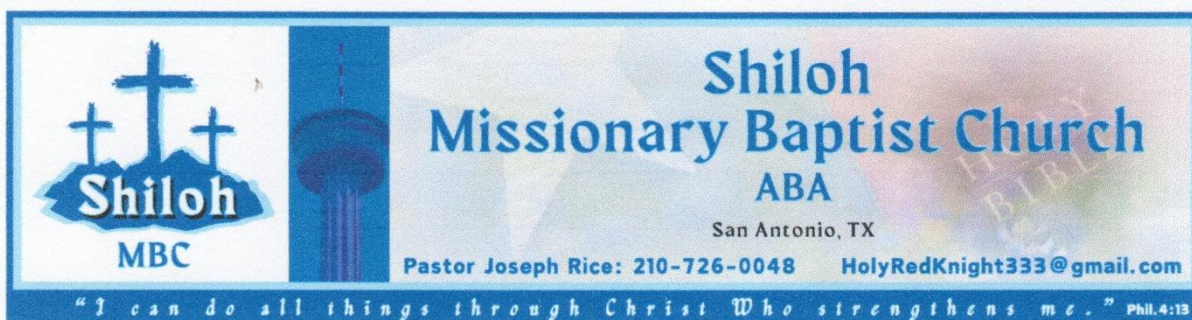

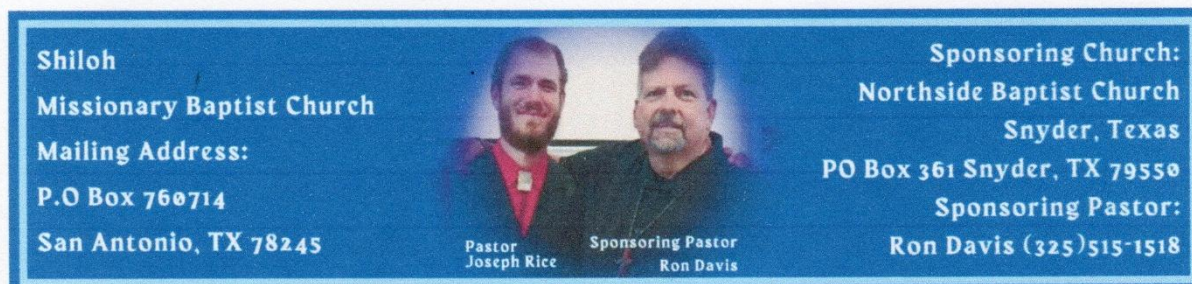
## March 2026 Mission Report
