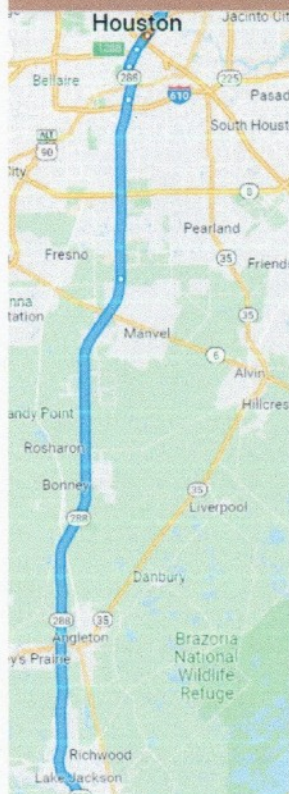

We saw God's protection in the storm, and his provision after the storm when we were loaned a generator for the 5-6 days that we were without electricity.
  - Community outreach through hurricane cleanup. Among our association of churches, there are great people who have a heart for disaster relief. The desire is not just to cut up fallen trees and clean up yards, but to see lives touched by the Gospel through these efforts. We are grateful for all of those who traveled here to give us these opportunities to show God's love to our local community.

### Emergency

Over the past several weeks, Amy has experienced low oxygen and has fallen (she lost all strength in her legs) several times. On July 16th, we went to the doctor for a routine 3 month appointment.



After the doctor looked at Amy's bloodwork and her oxygen level that day she sent her immediately to the Emergency Room. While there, we were told not only was Amy's oxygen low, her sodium level was **EXTREMELY** low and they were going to admit her to the ICU. Over the next week, they slowly brought her sodium level up to normal (it was some of her medications that had drastically decreased her sodium), and with the aid of an oxygen machine, stabilized her oxygen level. They literally saved her life, and I praise God for his guidance! She is having several follow-up appointments over the next month to determine what further treatment may be necessary for her oxygen. Thankfully, we have insurance, but we still have a bill of over \$900 due to our co-pay. Any help with this expense would be greatly appreciated. Please keep her in your prayers!

### Elijah and Isaac

Destiny is a teenager that has been attending our services for several months now. She knows Jesus as her Savior, and has been asking me how to lead her brothers to Christ. In the past, they have been not interested, and often changed the subject when she brought it up. Recently however, they have begun asking questions about the Bible, and she would answer them until they lost interest. Last week, the subject came up, and they spent a couple of hours asking her questions! When they no longer had any more questions, they asked if she could tell them more! Please pray for Elijah and Isaac to come to know Jesus Christ as their Savior very soon.
